Fetal Echocardiography: An intense review course

Course Description

This comprehensive 2.5 day course will provide participants with a detailed overview of fetal echocardiography. The course will review the embryology, anatomy, physiology and scanning planes of the fetal heart and describe numerous congenital anomalies, their ultrasound appearance and the planes and Doppler technique to identify them. A hands-on dissection of a pig heart will help participants get a better understanding of the 3D anatomy, the relative position of the great vessels and the position of the valves. Social activities are designed to allow discussion time with faculty and to network with peers.
